Instead of hearing your students say “I Can’t Do Math”, turn their comments into “Math Ain’t That Hard”. This session will provide instruction and practice for participants in regards to the various calculation strategies that are dictated by the new math standards. Participants will leave this session with flexibility in how they approach addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. From place-value strategies to calculating on number lines, from area models to the ratio table and proportionality, from whole numbers to decimals, fractions and integers, a multitude of alternative calculation strategies will be explored. Materials and activities experienced during the session will be ready to use the very next day in the classroom.
