- ◆ **Leaver data** - data on graduates, dropouts, and other school leavers identified during the 2015-2016 school year.

- ◆ Calculate compensatory entitlement
- ◆ Monitor special programs
- ◆ Report to the federal government
- ◆ Calculate retention
- ◆ Calculate basic profiles for AEIS
- ◆ Perform desk audits
