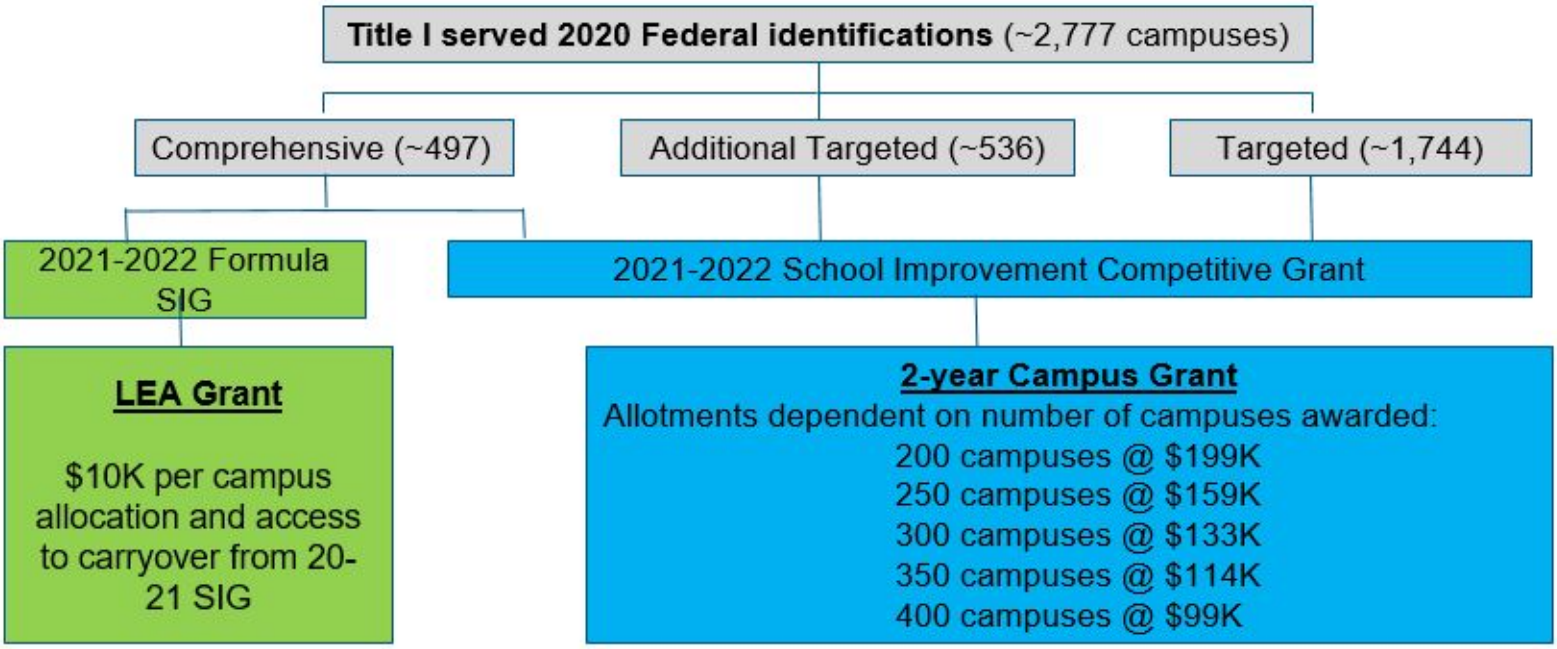


2021-2022 School Improvement Funding

What is the SIG grant?

- Formula Funding-2021-2022 Title I, 1003 School Improvement Grant
 - \$10,000 per eligible campus
 - Retain carryover from 2020-2021 Title I, 1003 School Improvement Grant
 - LOI due March 10th
- Competitive Funding-Title I, ESF-Focused Support Grant
 - 2 Year campus grant

What is the SIG grant?




Who is eligible for the Title I, 1003 School Improvement Grant (Formula Funding)?

- Title I campuses with the federal accountability label of Comprehensive(Identified/Progress) Support and Improvement in 2019 Accountability
- Eligible Campuses: Matagorda, Rice JH, Runge HS, Tidehaven Int, Wharton EI, Woodsboro EI, Dudley & Schorlemmer (VISD)



Formula Grant Implications

- Opting into funding opts your campus(es) into TEA School Improvement interventions and support and gives you access to unspent carryover from 2020-2021 SIG
 - Opting out of funding indicates that you will monitor School Improvement efforts locally in preparation for 2022 issuance of Accountability labels
- 

Who is eligible for the Title I, 1003 ESF-Focused Support grant?

- Title I campuses with the federal accountability label of Targeted Support or Additional Targeted Support and Improvement in 2019 Accountability
- The following districts have at least one eligible campus: Bay City, Bloomington, Boling, Calhoun, Columbus, Cuero, Edna, El Campo, Ganado, Goliad, Hallettsville, Industrial, Karnes City, Kenedy, Louise, Matagorda, Nordheim, Palacios, Refugio, Rice, Runge, Tidehaven, Van Vleck, Victoria, Wharton, Woodsboro, Yoakum, Yorktown

Grant Requirements

Formula Funding

- Continuation of ESF-aligned focus areas
- Evidence of ESC, ESC VIP, or external VIP capacity building supports required for new allocation
- Implementation and progress monitoring

Competitive Grant

- Selection of Vetted Support
 - Grant Path 1- ESC VIP (TIL)
 - Grant Path 2 - External VIP
- Implementation and Progress Monitoring
